Recent Highlights







In Ducklings and Twitchits we have been exploring down in the jungle. We have been exploring jungle playdoh, animals in rice and oats and playing with animals in gloop. We have enjoyed exploring our mud kitchen we have been making mud pies with sand and mud. We have also enjoyed exploring big cat rice play, elephant playdoh painting lizards. We are enjoying our transport theme and creating marks with the vehicles.









In Tiggys we have enjoyed creating Olympic craft and exploring the colours of the Olympic rings. We have been busy developing our physical skills and using the balance beams. WE have been exploring animals and experimented with different textures, animal theme tuff trays and learning their names and how they feel. We used a variety of resources to create animal paintings. We have moved onto Dinosaurs and experimented with the different marks they make in playdough. We used the dinosaurs to make marks in paint. We will now be busy learning about sea animals.





Over the last few weeks, Nutkins have enjoyed exploring activities around Olympic, cats, lions, elephants, lizards and dinosaurs. The children in Nutkins have enjoyed making Olympic obstacle courses in the garden to help develop their body movements in various ways. Nutkins looked closely at cats, lions, elephants and lizards on our special days, learning about facts to expand our vocabulary, elephant threading, lizard textured dough, elephant balancing game and exploring different sizes. The children have also been exploring dinosaur activities and learning to identify some dinosaurs using pictures to match them, the children enjoyed exploring fossil dough, dinosaur silhouettes and dinosaurs in gloop with dino eggs. Next month Nutkins will be exploring dinosaurs further, coconuts, favourite books and exploring different languages.







Over the last month we have enjoyed learning about animals. We celebrated some animal recognition days including world elephant day and international wolf day. Some of our favourite activities included creating animal masks, using different media to represent animals in the savannah and learning new facts.

In September we will be enjoying yoga and Spanish sessions again as well as learning all about the solar system.
