Recent Highlights







This month we have enjoyed learning about the farm. We have enjoyed vegetable painting, hand painting pigsties exploring small world farm animal and making animal noises. We have been busy exploring zoo animals and loved finding the animals in our dear zoo animal sack. We have loved exploring story books and exploring the texture of the 'That's not my... animals' books.







This month we have enjoyed learning about our five senses. Each day we have focused on a different sense and provided activities to support this such as sensory tray, musical shakers with rice and pasta and herby playdough; we also been exploring colours using Duplo blocks to created assorted colour marks and explored making colours with different paint. We will now be learning about movement and patterns using our bodies to explore movement to music and creating marks and patterns with paint.







This month the children have loved exploring their favourite books, we have been developing a keen interest in stories and have begun to use props and other items to develop this interest further. Our main favourites were 'Room on a broom' where we enjoyed creating our own characters using paint and being creative with a range of ingredients to create our own potions. We also have enjoyed 'A squash and a squeeze' where we have enjoyed retelling the story using small world animals, characters and the dolls house. We have also been learning about sunflowers and creating our own beautiful sunflowers.







During the month of September, we used our love for literature to guide our play and learning; we used books that centred on bears who were on adventures, our favourite stories included "Whatever Next" and "Paddington". We follow our interests and learn about the Circus. We had fun learning about all the different roles within the circus and performing different tricks. During the month of October, we will be exploring Autumn using our senses, we look forward to investigating and talking about our autumn treasures.
